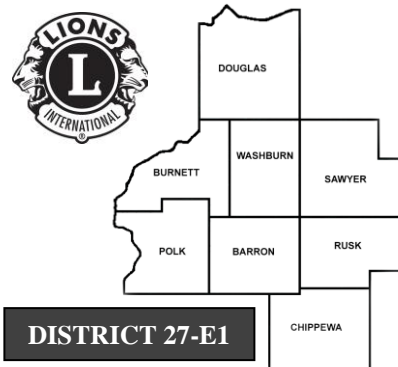

YOUTH SERVICE PROJECT AWARD APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

This application form is not intended to be lengthy and should not take an inordinate time to complete. Please keep the required parts of the application simple and brief. The required portion of the application form consists of the following three steps:

Step 1. Fill out the cover page of the APPLICATION FORM and ENDORSEMENT completely. Have the form signed as requested.

Step 2. Write brief narrative answers to the three questions that appear on the following pages. The questions are designed to help the reader comprehend the service project's goals, its execution, and its impact on the community.

Step 3. Provide observations/reflections by the students/members about their involvement in the service project. Include comments from at least three group members.

Providing additional information and documentation is optional.

Examples of additional documentation are pictures, local news articles, a letter of support from the group advisor, and comments from anyone who is affected by the project. Other supporting documents or evidence are possible. However, do not forward electronic disks or other electronic media with the application.

YOUTH SERVICE PROJECT AWARD GOALS AND DESCRIPTION

Describe the goals of the service project. What did the group members want to accomplish? Was there a perceived need or issue that the group wanted to address with the project?

Describe the service project. What events occurred? Who was involved in the project? How many members took part in the project? What is/was the time length? Where did the project occur?

YOUTH SERVICE PROJECT AWARD IMPACT AND OBSERVATIONS

Describe the total impact and effect of the project. What was accomplished and what impact did the project have? How did the members feel about their experience? What did the students learn from their experience? Did they meet their goals?

List or attach observations/reflections by group members. Include comments about the project from at least three (3) group members.
